Meeting was opened in due form by Vice-Chairman Nick Nekrosius. A roll call of officers was taken showing Chairman excused. All other officers were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were presented. Being no additions or corrections to those minutes, Vice-Chairman Nekrosius stated that the minutes would stand approved as presented.

Delegates briefly discussed the LaSalle Illinois Veterans Advisory Council meeting. It was noted that there are approximately 30 health care staff personnel that need to be hired in order to open all 200 beds. Until those personnel are hired, we will remain with about 174 beds filled. Veterans Assistance Commission delegates and alternates are asked to contact their state representative and state senator asking them to please help in seeing that these individuals are hired.

New Business: The Service Officer's Report was presented. As of March 2015 our veterans have been awarded \$817,617 in financial benefits. Motion was made by George Mason and seconded by Jerry Fuchs that the Service Officer's Report be accepted as presented. Motion passed.

Superintendent Rue presented the LaSalle County Board Roll Call Vote dated 12/29/14 pertaining to the VAC salary. He also presented the LaSalle County Treasures Transaction by Account of the LaSalle County Veterans Assistance Commission total budget as of March 24, 2015. He noted that our balance on hand in the LaSalle County Veterans Assistance Commission budget was \$637,164.80 as of March 24, 2015. As a result of our VAC office's fiscal responsibilities there was no need this year to levy a tax to adequately fund our VAC office total expenditures. There have been individuals who have contacted our VAC office requesting that we spend more money to reduce the balance on hand. Superintendent Rue stated his office will spend only what the law permits for those veterans who by statute are legally eligible for the cash assistance that is offered.

The LaSalle County Marine Corp League has elected Joe Navarro to be the delegate to the LaSalle County Veterans Assistance Commission from the Marine Corp League. All present welcomed Joe.

Meeting was opened in due form by Chairman Jim Ebner. A roll call of officers was taken showing all officers present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were presented. Being no additions or corrections to those minutes, Chairman Ebner stated the minutes would stand approved as presented.

Old Business: As previously requested, Superintendent Rue gave all delegates and alternates a copy of the Illinois Department of Veterans' Affairs Burial Grant Application for deceased Illinois veteran's dependents. He stated that this burial grant is for deceased service connected disabled WWII, Korean, Vietnam, Desert Storm and Peacetime veterans who had either died while in service or as a result of their service connected disabilities. He also gave the delegates and alternates a copy of the illnesses presumptively recognized for service connection for Vietnam veterans, Gulf War veterans, Afghanistan Veterans and others exposed to radiation.

New Business: The Service Officer's Report was presented for the month of May 2015, noting that our veterans and their dependents have received financial awards since December 2014 in the amount of \$1,520,162.00. A motion was made by Nick Nekrosius and seconded by Jim Nanowski that the Service Officer's Report be accepted as presented.

Delegate Joe Navarro discussed the need to setting up a combination of Veterans and Servicemembers Court Program. House Bill 5214 enrolled is the statute of this Act, which may be cited as the Veterans and Servicemembers Court Treatment Act. A brief discussion was held between those present at our Commission meeting. Superintendent Rue asked Delegate Joe Navarro to research the possibility of LaSalle County Veterans Assistance Commission looking into becoming one of the half a dozen counties in the state of Illinois which provide the service. Joe said he would report back at our next Commission meeting.

John Duback stated that his friend from the Illinois Department of Veterans Affairs, John Mieser will be putting on a program in Ottawa covering veteran benefits. He further stated that any veteran organization who wishes to have the Illinois Department of Veterans Affairs van stop at their social functions to put on this program of veterans benefits can contact John Duback at 815-993-3956.

Minutes of the July 2015 meeting was presented to those present. Being no additions or corrections to those minutes, Chairman Ebner stated the minutes would stand approved as presented.

New Business: The Service Officers Report was presented. As of July 2015 the LaSalle County veterans and their dependents have received \$2,027,701 in VA financial benefits. All questions pertaining to the Service Officers Report were answered. A motion was made by Jim Nanowski and seconded by George Mason that the Service Officers Report be accepted as presented. Motion passed.

Chairman Ebner discussed his attendance at the LaSalle County VAC Board meeting in July at the LaSalle County Nursing Home. He was very pleased with how cordial the County Board members were to him. He said he answered all the questions presented to him pertaining to the VAC. He said Chairman Small asked that the VAC Budget Recommendations for 2016 be presented at the August 10, 2015 VAC meeting at the LaSalle County Nursing Home pertaining to our expenditures.

A lengthy discussion ensued pertaining to the completion of our 2016 Budget Request for our VAC. The County Board minutes of May 2, 2012 Salary and Labor Committee meeting laid out a four year recommendation for different county offices. It showed an annual increase of \$2,500 for main department officials. As a result, the LaSalle County Veterans Assistance Commission suggested that our VAC office request a raise for its employee's payroll of \$5,000 with \$2,500 per employee. A motion was made by Jack Leininger and seconded by Nick Nekrosius that our payroll line item reflects a \$5000 increase with \$2,500 per employee. Motion passed unanimously.


